Family Fest Do's and Don'ts

Your booth or display should be interactive.

We want the public to be able to safely participate in your activity. Please refer to your Guide to safe Scouting. Have your booth/display reflect things that the youth are really going to be doing at their age level.

Your booth should be age and program appropriate.

You should only show off activities that their age Scouts actually do. Many of our guests won't know the difference, so be sure to explain the target age for your unit. For example a cub scout unit should not have a pioneering display and a troop should not have a Pinewood Derby track. Safety is also a must! All displays must be safe and age appropriate.

Keep in mind the physical limits of or display area.

Although the slingshot of the Angry Birds display is great, we won't have the space as in previous years. Please plan on a 10x10 space. If you need more room, please note it in the participation form and we will do our best to accommodate.
